



Notice of Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

The Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 regulations require each local authority to carry out a review of UK Parliamentary Polling Districts and Polling Places in its area within a 16 month period commencing from **1 October 2013**.

We are looking for feedback on any aspect of polling districts and/or polling places currently used and invite representation and comments from interested persons.

Local political parties and Councillors will be consulted and views are invited from electors within the Borough of Fylde as well as such persons as may have particular expertise in relation to access to premises or facilities for persons who have different forms of disability.

The consultation period for the review will commence on 1 October 2013 and end on 6 November 2013.

Although the review is of polling districts and polling places it is accepted that polling stations are inexorably linked to the review and comments are invited re those stations currently used and/or any suggested alternatives.
